

Parade registration form

Please Read the following regulations carefully and ensure that all members associated with your entry are familiar with these rules and regulations.

1. The Town of Strathmore reserves the right to refuse access to the parade by any entry deemed unsuitable or dangerous.
2. No smoking or alcoholic beverages are allowed on parade entries or by parade participants.
3. All units carrying people must be equipped with adequate restraining devices the can reasonably be considered capable of stopping anyone from falling from the unit.
4. If generators, lighting/ special effects are used, a fire extinguisher must accompany the float.
5. For safety reasons candy or advertising items **may only be handed out** along the parade route. Under no circumstances will throwing items from vehicles be allowed. To ensure comfort and safety of all spectators viewing the parade, water guns or apparatus that shoot water or other material are strictly prohibited.
6. Ample supervision of children must be provided, prior and during the parade. The ratio being a minimum of 1 adult to 8 children.
7. All drivers must have a valid driver's license and may be asked to present their license when they arrive at the staging area. Drivers must be a minimum of 18 years of age.

8. Noises must be kept to a reasonable level during the staging process. The only time required for sirens, blowing of horns, or playing loud music is during the parade itself. Suitable noise levels will be determined by the Town of Strathmore staff and any requests to adjust sound levels must be obeyed.
9. Those who wish to bike, skateboard, rollerblade, scooter, use ATV's etc. during the parade must wear proper protective equipment, especially helmets (regardless of age).
10. Town of Strathmore staff and law enforcement officers have the right to pull the livestock entry off the route at the first suitable location if the management of any livestock should be a problem.
11. All participants must assume all liability relating to or arising from their involvement in the Strathmore Stampede Parade. The applicant will hold the Town Of Strathmore and its volunteers harmless of any and all claims, actions or causes arising from their participation (see attached liability waiver).
12. In the event of an **EMERGENCY**, parade participants must move to the **RIGHT of the parade route** to allow clear access for Emergency Vehicles. In the event of a large emergency and the parade must stop, turn into the nearest intersection to your right and cautiously proceed back to the staging area for further direction.
13. Floats must be of good quality and taste.
14. Your float number must be clearly visible for judging purposes.

15. No firearms, fireworks, explosives, projectiles, catapults, or pyrotechnics of any kind.
16. Once the float is positioned in the assembly area, a driver and representative must be in attendance at all times.
17. The use of cell phones is prohibited while driving the vehicle on the parade route.
18. Float beds must be sturdy and capable of carrying the weight to be imposed.
19. Floats must be escorted to and from the parade site. If unescorted, proper running lights should be attached to the float vehicles.
20. Float vehicles must be properly registered and insured.
21. The float vehicle must be properly serviced for gasoline, water, oil, brakes, tires and battery prior to entry into the parade. NO extra gasoline, other than in the vehicle's tank, can be carried on the float vehicle.
22. All vehicle exhaust systems must be clear of any decorative materials and properly ventilated.
23. Portable generators used on the float must be securely mounted on the vehicle or other substantial base. A minimum of 12 inches clearance must separate any part of the generator from decorative materials.
24. Generators must be equipped with firmly attached metal exhaust lines, installed so to terminate either at a common exhaust serving both vehicle and generator or to the exterior of the float in the same manner as the vehicle exhaust.

I acknowledge that we have read, and will conform to, all rules and regulations established for this event. Additionally, upon receiving notification of acceptance of our entry, we will ensure that all participants associated with our entry are informed of and will abide by the established rules and regulations; and participants are aware of the possible media coverage.

I also agree to follow the Alberta Traffic Safety Act and adhere to all Government Highway Regulations.
